

Foulden Village Hall Update 12th May 2021



The Village Hall has reopened from May 10th for certain uses, subject to the current Scottish Government Covid-19 guidelines and regulations.

Sanitization, social distancing and facemasks are necessary for anyone entering and hiring organisations must complete and satisfy their own Risk Assessments and any additional requirements of national oversight bodies. Extra professional cleaning has been arranged by the Hall Committee but users are also asked to complete their own pre- and post-event cleaning.

The monthly "Meet and Treat" meeting has restarted on the second Thursday of each month, running from 10.00 to 11.30 am. This is a chance for folk to come together for an informal chat over tea or coffee, to visit the Book Exchange (Bring one - Take one) and often there is a special activity such as Floor Curling, a quiz or a visitor speaking. The 100 Club Draw takes place at around 11.00 am.

June 10th will be a special morning as we launch the Foulden Recipe Book, a collection of favourite recipes from local people (plus one or two guest contributors). This will be available for £6.00 and all proceeds will go to the Hall funds as costs of production have been met by generous sponsorship from local businesses.

It is hoped that some of the other Hall regular events such as the Films at Foulden and the monthly dances will restart in the autumn (probably September) and the Committee are already working on a new programme of exciting activities for all ages in the village.
